Proceedings :-

1. The proceedings of the previous meeting were read and

confirmed.

2. In this meeting, the Principal informed the members about the accreditation of our college by NAAC vis-a-vis certificate received from the NAAC office, Bangalore. The Principal informed happily to the members that college has got Grade 'B' by NAAC and appreciated the efforts made by each and every faculty. And all of the members of the Staff Council congratulated the Principal and each other.
3. The principal informed the Council members that from current session i.e. 2015-2018 Semester System is going to be implemented. It is mandatory for all of us.
4. He explained in detail about the regulation duration and other aspects related to Semester system. He read it-aloud 13 page regulation issued by Vinoba Bhave University Haranibag.
5. He informed the members that an academic year is divided into two Semesters: July and January in each semester courses are offered in 15 teaching weeks and the conduct-remaining 5 weeks are to be utilized for the conduct of examinations and evolution purposes. Each week has minimum 30 working hours spread over 6 days or weeks.
6. The principal informed the Council members that in each academic year there shall be two Semesters. Each Honours Course shall be divided into six semesters comprising of 1600 marks.
7. He informed that an honours student shall study two subsidiary subjects and as Compulsory language paper up to fourth Semester. Total marks of each subsidiary and Compulsory Language paper shall be 400.
8. The principal informed the Council members that in 5th Semester shall be compulsory paper on Skill Develop-

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-ment (SD) and Environmental Science (ES) in the 6th Semester. Total marks in each Subject shall be 100

9. He informed the pass marks in honours for both theory and practical papers shall be 45%. Pass marks in subsidiary subjects shall be 33% for theory papers and 40% for practical papers. Pass marks for compulsory language paper shall be 83%. Pass marks in MIL Non-Hindi and MG shall also be 33%, in aggregate, however as student shall have to score at least 15 marks in each of the papers.

10. In this meeting, it was resolved that for every Honours course/subject, there shall be seat limit in the following manner (Both wings):

Subjects	Boys Wing	Girls Wing
Economics (H)	40	40
English (H)	40	40
Psychology (H)	40	40
Political Science (H)	60	60
History (H)	60	60
Hindi (H)	40	40
B. Com (H)	120+120 (Two section)	100+100 (Two section)

11. It was resolved unanimously that from the next academic session i.e. 2015-18 admission to honours course shall be strictly on the basis of cut-off marks prescribed in the following manner:-

- (1) For students passing out from Guru Nanak College (JAC) obtaining - 55%
- (2) For students passing out from other College (JAC, RANCHI) obtaining - 60%
- (3) For students passing from other Boards (CBSC, ICSE) obtaining - 75%

12. In this meeting, it was also resolved that Honours courses students will opt. subsidiary subjects (two) in a prescribed manner. for this Dr. Munishwar Prasad and Dr. Sanjay Prasad

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were given the responsibilities to prepare a Honours Subsidary composition. They were also asked to submit the chart as early as possible to the Principal.

13. The matter of change in the timing of Boys' wing for Commerce Students came for discussion, in fact, this matter was raised by one of the honorable members of IQAC, Mr K. K. Harodia Chartered Accountant.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
