1. The proceedings of the previous meeting dated <u>18th of September</u>, <u>2021</u> were read, and confirmed.

2. Issues arising out of the previous meetings:

- (a) The members felt satisfied that all the decisions taken in the previous meeting were carried out sincerely.
- (b) It was informed by the principal that the IIQA of the college for second cycle assessment and accreditation was submitted to the NAAC on 21st of September 2020, as was decided by the Governing Council. The IIQA of the college was approved by the NAAC on 29th September 2020, which gave the college 45 days' time for submission of self-Study Report (SSR) The Self Study Report of the college was submitted on 31st October 2020 after the same was approved by the IQAC.

Students' satisfaction Survey (S.S.S.) was started by the NAAC on 2nd November; and good response was given sent by the students. On 25th December, a list was received from NAAC seeking clarifications from the college on a number of issues. The reply with detailed clarifications was sent by the college on the 2nd of January 2021. Now the response of the NAAC was awaited.

The members expressed satisfaction over the steps taken by the college; and hoped that the college would get good response in the matter.

- (c) The Secretary and the Principal were authorized to take all required steps for some minor touches here and there in the buildings of the college; and to acquire the required furniture, computers, Projectors and other appliances, which may be urgently needed.
