## **PROCEEDINGS**-

The proceedings of the previous meeting dated 29-10-2020 were read and confirmed.

The meeting of IQAC was started with a welcome note by the principal, Prof. P. Shekhar. He welcomed all the members of the Cell and introduced the new members' Students Representatives: Arjun Singh, Divya Burnwal; Alumni Representative: Prof. Amresh Kumar Choudhary, Society Representative: Mr. A. K. Sahay. The Principal also congratulated Mr. Sahay for being elected the president of Dhanbad Bar Association.

## **Issues arising out, and action taken Report**

It was reiterated by the Principal that the second cycle of assessment and accreditation by NAAC was done in 2020 itself as the result of the first cycle was declared on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2015.He further said that IIQA, and the SSR for the second cycle were submitted on time (in 2020 itself), but the NAAC Peer-Team visit got delayed due to the devastating state of COVID 19 Pandemic. The schedule for Peer-Team visit (as for now) provided by NAAC

is 09<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> July 2021. He mentioned that 95% of preparation for the visit was done and remaining 5% of the preparation would be taken up in the month of June.

He specifically pointed out that the platform of IQAC was the most potent medium to ensure communication among all stakeholders.

The members of Governing Body congratulated the IQAC for publishing the seminar volume "Imagining the World: Literature, Philosophy, Myth and Reality" which was the result of the National Seminar sponsored by IQAC and organized by Department of English, Guru Nanak College, in the month of July 2019. Also, all members expressed satisfaction and happiness that college library was not just fully automated, but had acquired the membership of UGC Inflibnet; to which more than five hundred students and almost all the teachers had got connected.

Members were happy to note that the library had adopted KOHA as the software for use.

The meeting proceeded with a detailed discussion of NAAC-Peer-Team visit. Essential feedbacks were provided by the Students' Representatives, Arjun Singh and Divya Burnwal. Arjun mentioned that the College had been providing sufficient support and encouragement to the students in every possible way. He specifically expressed thankfulness towards the students-friendly approach of the teachers and appreciated their efforts.

It was informed by the coordinator IQAC that the feedback from all stakeholders had been collected in an organized manner even during the pandemic. Three sets of online "Student Satisfaction Survey" were carried out by the college through its website in the months of June, August and October 2020; and the response of the students was huge and satisfactory.

PTMs were organized by five departments and the response was highly encouraging. Parents and guardians were happy and satisfied with the work of the college.

The report of "feedback reviews" carried out by "the committee for security and analysis" in its meeting dated 12.04.2021; was presented before the members of IQAC, which was appreciated.

There being no other issue to discuss, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.
