
Awareness lecture on The Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961 and the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005

On 30th October 2023, in the Multipurpose Hall of Guru Nanak College, Dhanbad (Women's Branch), GNC Alumni Association (former student organization, an organization recognized by the Society Act 1860) created awareness among girl students on serious issues like dowry system

and domestic violence was organised. As the keynote speaker, Prof. Dr. Amresh Choudhary was invited from Law College, Dhanbad. The formal

conduct of the program was completed under the guidance of Principal Dr. Sanjay Prasad. The keynote speaker was welcomed with a budding plant. Main speaker Prof. Amresh Choudhary expressed concern over the current increasing crimes like the dowry system and domestic violence and strongly condemned it. Such crimes are a hindrance in the development of society and need to be curbed as soon as possible. This can be curbed to a great extent through legal awareness. Addressing the girl students, he said that crimes like dowry and domestic violence are cancer and termites for our society which are slowly eating away the peace and tranquility of the society.

He gave legal information to the girl students and made them aware about the correct use of this law. He said that having knowledge about the laws against domestic violence and using them are two different things in the public mind. He mentioned the Human Rights Act and also discussed some important problems while interacting with the girl students. In his statement he also discussed the statistics of domestic violence, which occurs in the society due to lack of information.

Prof. In-Charge Ranjana Das, in her address, gave the message to the girl students to come out of shyness and hesitation and understand the difference between personal and social problem. Today most of the domestic problems have started emerging because people consider them related to their reputation and suffer harassment.

Stage management was smoothly done by Prof. Daljeet Singh and formal vote of thanks was given by Prof. Sanjay Sinha.

More than 100 girl students from different disciplines were present in the program.
