"Movies: A Negative Influence on Youth"

A group discussion on the topic "Movies: A Negative Influence on Youth" was held at Guru Nanak College, Dhanbad, organized by the Department of Vocational Studies- BCA on 21.10.2024 under the supervision of coordinator of BCA Prof. Pushpa Tiwari.

Miss Ghanishtha Verma, the coordinator for the discussion, introduced the topic to the students and opened the forum for discussion. Miss Surabhi Kashyap and Miss Rashi Poddar served as panellists, offering their insights.

The aesthetic value of cinema and how it influences society and is influenced by society was discussed. The movies like 'Lapata Ladies', '12th Fail', 'Animal', 'Kabir Singh' and few animated movies were used as examples to compare and contrast the effects of movies on the youth.
