Proceedings of the meeting dated 11th January 2024 :-

The meeting with a welcome note by the Principal, Dr. Sanjay Prasad. Thereafter, the proceedings of the previous meeting dated 26th May 2023 were read and confirmed with the approval of the chairperson.

A detailed action taken report was presented explaining the progress made on the decision and action from the previous meeting and it was observed that most of the targeted actions were executed successfully.

A comprehensive report was presented detailing each and every minute of the Cultural Exchange tour of our college to Punjab in three ~~leading~~ universities - (1) Punjabi University, Patiala, (2) Panjab University, Chandigarh and (3) Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar. The programme was held between 12th Sept and 22nd Sept. 2023, in which, the students of our college showcased cultural aspects of Jharkhand and Punjab through performance of dance and music which was applauded with great accolades. It was suggested that such events should continue.

It was reported by the principal that the enrolment of students to our BBA course has grown to a sizeable number and in order to accommodate the growing number of students in the vocational courses, BCA & BBA and moreover, viewing to their related academic activities, infrastructural development in form of fully equipped five class rooms including lecture hall, library cum reading room and washrooms (for boys and girls separately) on the third floor of the vocational block has started and nearing its completion.

It was submitted by the principal that the AQAR of our college for the Academic Year 2022-2023 was successfully submitted on the NAAC Portal. He mentioned the efforts and verification of all criteria in charge in this regard with a note of thanks.

The principal apprised that the college has applied to BMMU University for extension of affiliation of BBA course being run at our college for next three academic sessions - 2024-2027, 2025-2028, 2026-2029 and with regard to it,

an inspection team duly constituted by the university are to visit our college to inspect on necessary institutional parameters as adequate infrastructure needed for successful run of BBA course. And the ongoing infrastructural development would certainly be helpful towards obtaining the affiliation and moreover, the college fulfills all required parameters in this regard, he added.

The principal submitted the college proposes to grant free ship to its bonafide girls students. The president in the chair affirmed with positive note on the proposal and told to go ahead with the plan and come up with a draft plan of action. Thereafter, a draft committee of three persons was constituted by the principal - Dr. Minu Malkhandi, HOD, Polse, Prof Sanjay Kr. Lunkar, Bursar, Prof Dipak Kumar, Coordinator, IQAC. The team reported with the draft plan of action to be reviewed and implemented.

The principal submitting that the five-year Institutional Development plan is on the verge of conclusion in the year 2025, fulfilling the Institutional Vision of Pursuit for excellence. It was further added that a draft plan of action is being worked upon and very soon it would be placed for review and approval.

Since there were no other matters left for discussion, the meeting ended with a note of thanks to the chair.
